

# OODNADATTA WIN

M. Benz (North Suburban) scored an easy win in the S.A. Homing Pigeon Association's 540-mile event from Oodnadatta last Saturday.

Clocking at about 6.21 p.m., Benz had the first of the six birds to reach home in the day and won by 20 yards a minute from A. Goodger, Hampstead.

The other four included two from the Elizabeth and Salisbury area owned by Nys and Son and R. Fleming, one to T. Quinn, Hyde Park and one to Hampstead owner, B. Strange.

However, between closing time Saturday night and opening time Sunday, several other birds reached home in the moonlight.

D. Briggs, Hyde Park, who did not have a bird at 9.30 p.m. found two arrivals home just before 5 a.m. Sunday to finish third and fourth.

Returns were about 60 p.c.

The Combine and Union held a joint event from Junee. W. Downing won the race, clocking Sunday morning.

A return of 30 p.c. was recorded.

## 1,000 Miler At Port Elliot

The first of nearly 300 birds released north of Barrrow Creek, N.T. on Sept. 13 was found in its loft at Port Elliot early last Saturday morning.

Raced by N. Clark, the two-year-old B.C.H. won the Marree-Port Elliot race earlier this year.

Not competing in the main Association 1,000 mile race, this grand hen took part in the joint Port Elliot, Victor Harbor and Strathalbyn event.

Her bloodlines will be included in this column as soon as full particulars are obtained.
