

Poor start to race

Another bad get-away resulted on Saturday when about 4,500 SAHPA birds were reluctant to leave Maryborough — less than 50 p.c. made home in the day.

Released in overcast weather at 8 a.m. (Eastern time), the contestants were hesitant in departing.

R. Blyth, Hampstead, clocked the winner just after 4.20 p.m. to win from clubmate, H. Webber, with K. Shinkfield, Skyline Continental, just behind in third place.

Despite the poor start, and the resultant large gaps between many arrivals later, the first 50 or more birds came home closely on each others tails.

The total of 4,130 birds representing 252 owners competed in the major association race.

The Union and Combine flew slow races from Oodnadatta, 540 miles, when the leaders did not reach Adelaide until Sunday afternoon.

T. Jacobs won the Union's event and the Combine's race went to F. Taylor.
