Game Changer Ring Race

Concept:

To provide prizemoney to flyers (and/or ring owners) participating in the "Your Business" Classic Ring Race whilst flying in SAHPA races.

How to Enter in the event.

Designated Rings are to be purchased at a cost of \$25.00 for 2 off (Purchased as pairs.)

Prizemoney.

Subject to the number of rings sold the prize pool to be split equally between the races chosen for the competition (4 races on the NW line, 4 races on the NE line and excluding 5 bird limit races)

It is anticipated prizes will be paid 14 days after the end of the race season.

The aim is to provide a prize in each race, for every 50 birds entered in the competition to a maximum of 12 Prizes.

Should only 3 birds be in the prize list then the payout would be based on the 1st 2nd and 3rd prizes but should 7 or 7+ birds be timed then the prizes would be awarded as per the 7 prizes list.

A single prize of \$250.00 (approx. 6% of prize pool and 1 off for each line) will be paid to the flyer with the highest average race velocity in 2 off races on the same line.

What do I have to do to compete?

The birds are to be entered in any of the races identified for the competition in the normal manner for a SAHPA race. The birds will also be able to compete in SAHPA race result.

There is no need to identify the birds entering the event as all are eligible. The birds performance in the SAHPA overall event will transfer to the "Game Changer Ring Race" result. i.e. The velocity of the flyers or purchasers bird will dictate its position in the event. It is the owner's/purchaser's responsibility to ensure any eligible birds time is recognised and calculated in the SAHPA result system. The birds velocity MUST appear in the SAHPA Open result to be eligible.

Prizemoney Breakdown.

If 1000 rings are sold we are looking at better than \$12,000 in the pool.

Should - 175 Pairs of rings be sold (more will only increase prize pool)	\$ 4375.00
Sundry Expenses (Approx. 7.5% for Postage and various expenses)	(\$250.00)
Average velocity Prizes (Approx 12% of pool) 2 off @ \$250.00	(\$500.00)

Based on \$455.00.

If the following number of birds home and are recorded in the race result, then the payout will be as follows per bird:-

5 Maximum 7 Prize
Based on 1/50 Birds 1st - \$150.00 0.00 2nd - \$100.00 00 3rd - \$60.00 00 4th - \$50.00 00 5th - \$40.00 6th - \$30.00 7th - \$25.00

The prize allocation and number of prizes will be advised prior to the event start date based on ring sales.

What if no birds are clocked in race time?

(The race will close when the SAHPA event closes)

The prizemoney will be transferred to the prize allocated to the last race on that line and if still not taken will be added to the average velocity prize.

How do I purchase rings?

It is planned that the rings will be available from Alan Agar, Sofia Thalbourne and Tom Tirrell. EFT Payment to a detailed bank account will be the preferred method of payment. Postage will be at the purchasers expense.

Sale of rings (SAHPA -2020) for the 2021 event will cease 31^{st} March 2021. We could make this earlier to get them in??.

Is there a limit to the number of rings I can buy?

Yes. 20 birds per owner or flyer.

Can anybody buy rings for the competition?

Yes, however the birds must be coupled to a registered SAHPA member and record a velocity in one of the selected SAHPA races in the nominated flyers name.

Where will the races be from.

The aim is to have the first 8 SAHPA Races (4 on each line excluding 5 Bird Limit Races), as the races for the "My Business Classic Ring Race".

Shortened race programme or no payout on a race.

Unpaid money will be added to the average velocity prize (on the same line) should this occur.

What if the race programme is cancelled?

Money will be held in trust and be added to the prize pool for the 2022 Season.
