8. MEETINGS 8.1 Annual general meetings

8.1.1 The committee shall call an annual general meeting in accordance with the Act and these rules within 3 calendar months of the end of the financial year and provide 21 days' notice to members. 8.1.2 The order. 8.3 Notice of general meetings 8.3.1 At least 21 days' notice of any general meeting shall be given to members. The notice shall set out where and when the meeting will be held, and particulars of the nature and order of the business to be transacted at the meeting. 8.3.2 A notice may be given by the association to any member by serving the member with the notice personally, or by sending it by email or post or posted on the SAHPA website. 8.3.3 Where a notice is sent: (a) and the service is effected by properly addressing, prepaying and/or posting correspondence containing the notice, and (b) unless the contrary is proved, service will be taken to have occurred at the time at which the correspondence was sent.

Current constitution 8.5. Voting at general meetings.

8.5.1 Subject to these rules, every member of the association is entitled to vote at a meeting of the association. Attendance at that meeting is required for a valid vote.

A notice of the meeting will also advise members of the voting options available, personally attending the meeting and voting in accordance with instructions from the Chairperson.

OR a voting slip may be returned by normal post to the General Secretary at 10 Baulderstone Road, Gepps Cross,

OR by personally handing to the Gen Secretary,

OR by email direct from the members personal email address.

In the event of a tied vote, the chairperson shall have the casting vote.

In all instances voting slips must be with the General Secretary 7 days before the AGM.
