- 1) SAHPA Committee have reviewed Australian National Racing Pigeon Board ANRPB recommendations and have decided to revise the race program to points within our state and avoid RotaVirus hotspots at Pt Augusta and Wellington.
- 2) The Whyalla, Pt. Augusta and Pt. Pirie clubs are racing west this year so we have avoided racing west line
- 3) The South East Line has been put on hold due to the Wellington outbreak and the limited distance we can fly before we reach the border, next year once the vaccine is available the three years of SE line will start.
- 4) The North East Line was considered but we are limited to 300km before we reach the border
- 5) The North Line and swing to North West line was agreed, the initial race points are short of Port Augusta to avoid risking contamination and then we swing more inland east of Port Augusta before skipping over Port Augusta
- 6) This year we will return to price per bird per race, as it is too difficult to know how many birds we will have race the season and to avoid refunding money should the season be suspended due to any virus outbreaks. Once a vaccine is available we plan to return to the very successful prepaid scheme.
- 7) Decided to not run Verco series this year as all races are on the North Line
- 8) Decided to start the season one week later and finish earlier, no Angel Flight race this year, Redhill is a club race
- 9) Clocking Centres will need to have 6 Members present which are paid up Financial Members of SAHPA
