

Harshegyi Wins Marree

M. Harshegyi (East Suburban) won the S.A.H.P.A. Marree race from 3,933 birds and 242 other owners on Saturday.

Harshegyi's win, worth 20 points, put him in the lead for the association's aggregate award. He took the lead away from D. Agostino (Campbelltown) who failed to score in Saturday's event.

Others to take more prominent places in the aggregate event after good Marree performances include C. Hawke (East Suburban), H. Ford (Glynde) and A. Walford (East Adelaide).

All easy races, the three Marree events have done little to cull out the duds, and with very few losses resulting. The open Oodnadatta is certain to attract heavy nominations.

Other events decided on Saturday were held from Maryborough and Bendigo. The Union conducted a five-bird limit and an open race from Maryborough and the Combine flew from Bendigo.

The Union's limit release was made at 6.30 a.m. and because of fog which moved in later, the open birds were delayed until 8 a.m.

However, the open contestants made up considerable time and both fixtures were decided in the day.

The Bendigo birds also reached home in time for the positions to be filled on Saturday night.
